

Participant Agreement – Image Rights & Prize Payment

La French Tech Shanghai AI Hackathon 2026

Between the undersigned:

La French Tech Shanghai, hereafter the “Organizer”

Any individual participating in the Hackathon, hereafter the “Participant”

This Agreement is supplementary to and independent from the Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) signed by the Participant in connection with the Hackathon.

1. Image and Content Rights

1.1 Authorization to Use Image and Content

The Participant hereby expressly authorizes the Organizer to capture, reproduce, record, edit, adapt, publish, and distribute, free of charge, the Participant’s image, likeness, voice, name, professional affiliation, photographs, video recordings, audio recordings, screenshots, project presentations, pitches, demonstrations, and non-confidential extracts of works produced during the Hackathon.

1.2 Scope of Use

Such Content may be used for communication and promotion of the Hackathon, publication on websites, social media platforms, newsletters, press releases, and recap materials. This authorization is granted worldwide, for all media formats, and for the entire legal duration of protection.

2. Prize Awards and Payment Modalities

2.1 Team-Based Prize Allocation

Each winning team must designate one single team member as the official recipient of the prize payment.

2.2 Single Payment – Internal Distribution

2.2 Single Payment – Internal Distribution

The Organizer shall make one single payment per winning team to the Designated Recipient only. The payment will be issued in RMB by wire bank transfer to the Designated Recipient China bank account upon receipt from the Designated Recipient of invoices (fapiao) totalling the amount of the money prize (5 000 RMB or 20 000 RMB).

The internal distribution of the prize by the Designated recipient is entirely at the team's discretion.

2.3 Release of Liability

All team members waive any claim against the Organizer relating to the division or non-division of the prize money.

2.4 Compliance and Formalities

Prize payment may be subject to identity verification and regulatory requirements. Failure to provide required information may result in delayed or forfeited payment.

3. Acceptance

Participation in the Hackathon implies full and unconditional acceptance of this Agreement.
